






55TH CHIEF OF ENGINEERS' PRIORITIES



SPD NAVIGATION – PROGRAM STATUS



- \$146M O&M Nav budget (FY21)
 - Work plan has increased substantially
 - Currently ~45% of total O&M budget
- 27 California ports, 429 miles of Federal channel, 35 miles of coastal structures
- PACNAVCOP: Government dredge & Regional hopper dredging contract coordination across three divisions (SPD, NWD, & POD)
