

WASHINGTON – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Civil Works Program (Corps) released today a list of the programs included as part of President Biden's [Justice40 Initiative](#), which aims to deliver 40% of the overall benefits of climate, clean energy, affordable and sustainable housing, clean water, and other investments to disadvantaged communities that are marginalized, underserved, and overburdened by pollution.
